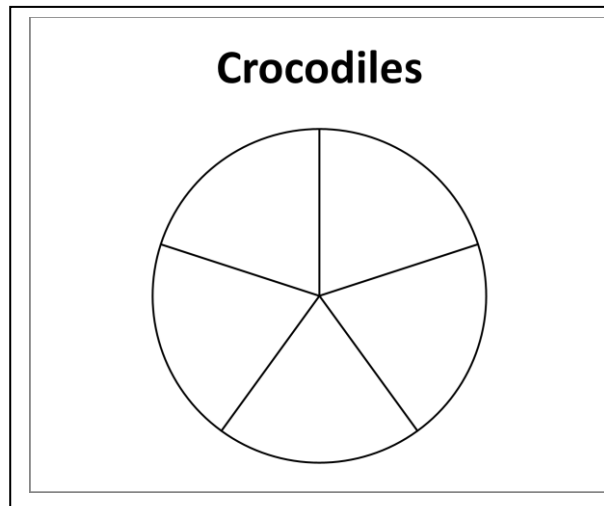
In the pie chart below can you fill in the areas which represent each species using the key:

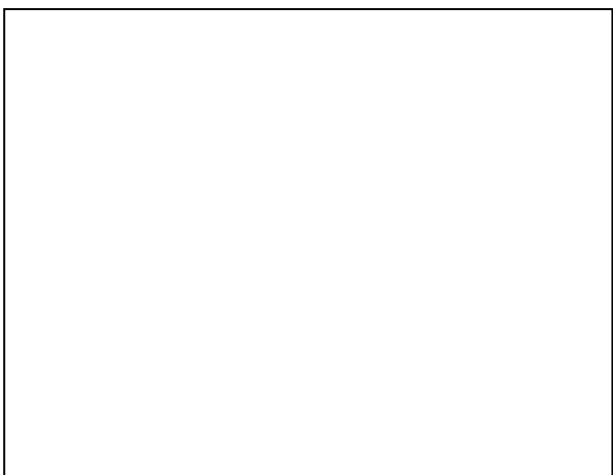
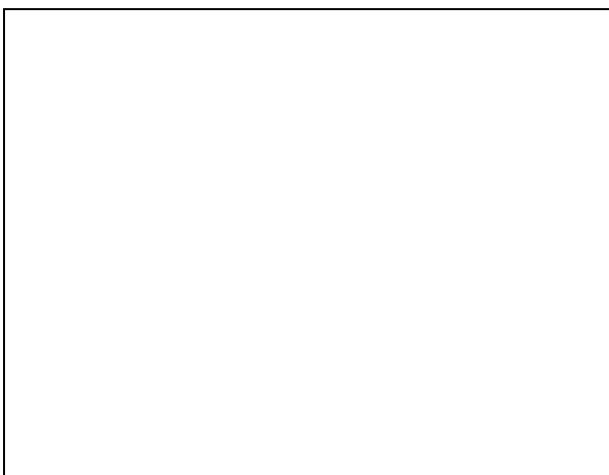
