



Key Stage 0 Answer Sheet

The Key Stage 0 question sheet only has one question which requires the children to give an answer which may be marked as right or wrong. The question which this refers to is the second question on the sheet. The first activity in the set asks the children to colour in a Tiger based upon their memory of what the Tigers at the park look like, while the final activity is designed to purely get the children involved with interacting with another species of primate.

This final activity gives an opportunity for the teacher or helper to give the children some further information about the Capuchins, which they can best explain by getting the children to interact with them. It can be very rewarding to see an animal imitate what one does, no matter what your age is. It is possible to explain that in order for a young Capuchin to learn which food items are safe to eat, how to avoid danger and how to get in to food items such as nuts, they watch and imitate the older animals within their group.
