Yemen Chameleon



Fun fact: This chameleon can change colour, but not to any colour it wants. It can only change its colours to various shades of yellow, brown, green, white and black, to allow it to blend to its surroundings to an extent.

These lizards are solitary with strictly one male per tree. They can vary in length from 12 inches to 24 inches with the females being at the smaller end of this scale.

Here we have Mowgli our male wolf, he was born here at WWP in 2017. He lives with his mum, Dakota.

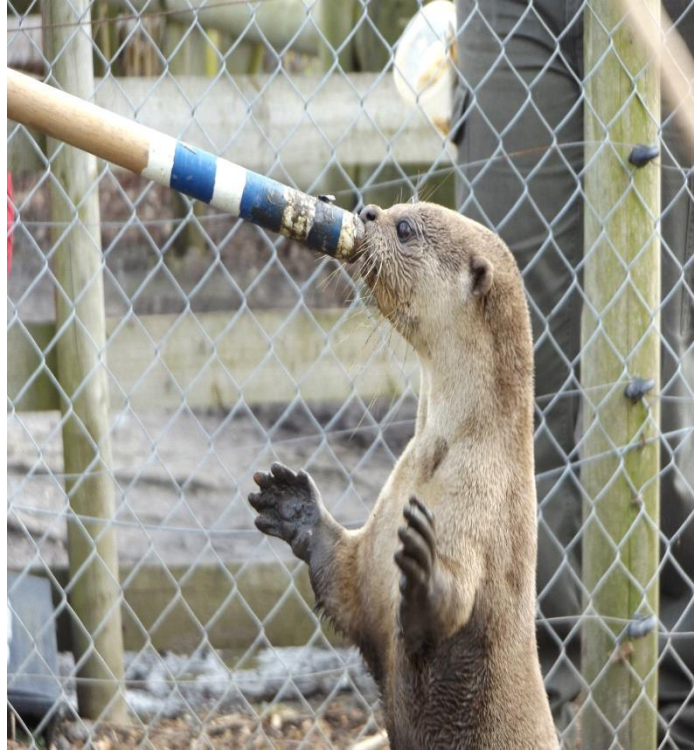
Fun fact: European Wolves have been genetically identified as being the main wild descendant for the domesticated dog.
